Back by popular demand - the Chicago Genealogical Society will be sponsoring a bus tour of a number of genealogically interesting Chicago neighborhoods. The neighborhoods were chosen in relation to the marvelous mass of literary work done in Chicago over the years. The neighborhoods to be visited had much influence on how Chicago authors viewed the world and which was reflected in their work. The hopeful purpose of the tour for genealogists is to emphasize a similar influence on families who lived there and whose descendants may have been influenced in the same way. Many of the neighborhoods which will be visited have not changed greatly over the years. Seeing where one's ancestors lived can provide genealogically interested descendants with new insights into the lives of their families. The tour will be led by Craig Pfannkuche of the Chicago Genealogical Society who specializes in Chicago family history research and has a love for historic Chicago writers. Some of the authors & books to be mentioned on the tour are: SISTER CARRIE (Theodore Dreiser), SO BIG (Edna Ferber), TARZAN & the MARTIAN CHRONICLES (Edgar Rice Burroughs), various works (Ernest Hemmingway), DIVISION STREET (Studs Terkel), WIZARD OF OZ (L. Frank Baum), MAN WITH THE GOLDEN ARM (Nelson Algren), THE PIT (Frank Norris), MY THIRTY YEARS AT HULL HOUSE (Jane Addams), THE JUNGLE (Upton Sinclair), A RAISIN IN THE SUN (Lorraine Hansberry) and many more.
